## **Foreword**

Welcome and thank you for your purchase of SEO Link Dominator. SEO Link Dominator is a piece of software developed by myself as a tool to use within my own business. I passed on the tool to other business colleagues who could also use this TOOL in their own businesses and they suggested a few additions to the software so that they could also use in their businesses, so I decided to release the tool to the public for general use to help others.

Generally when you signup to sites with all your information the following would normally happen:

- type in the url
- goto the sign up page
- Fill in all of your information manually
  - o First name
  - o Last Name
  - o Email
  - o Username
  - o Password
  - o Password confirmation

This stage would take around 3-4 minutes

Then you would

- Verify your email from a link sent to you
- Go back to the site
- Login back in manually
- Goto the profile page and choose edit
- Add in you data manually
  - o Site name
  - o Site url
  - o Signature with links back to your site
  - o Anchor text

This stage will take an additional 3-5 minutes

With the software you would simply do the following:

- Choose your url to sign up in the software (takes seconds)
- Click the 'signup' button
- The software navigates to the first site automatically
- Goto the signup page
- Right click the mouse on the signup page and choose 'Auto Fill'
- Fields are auto filled with your chosen profile data
- Click Submit

Instead of 3-4 minutes this stage now takes 'LESS' than 1 minute.

Then you would:

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- Verify your email from a link sent to you
- Go back within the software for a list of the sites that you signed up
- Choose the ones to create 1 way links
- Click the 'Create' button
- Goto the Login page and right click the mouse and choose 'Auto Fill' and the user and password are auto filled in then click 'Login'
- Goto the profile page and choose edit
- Right click the mouse on the signup page and choose 'Auto Fill'
- Field are auto filled with your chosen profile data
- Click Submit

And you're all done.. Semi automation at its 'Best'

Again we are talking 'LESS' than 1 minute..

So we are reducing the whole process that of creating a link back to your site from a possible 8 minutes to less than 1-2 minutes.

If we have 80 sites to signup then doing this manually would take

$$50 * 8 \text{ Minutes} = 400 \text{ minutes} = 6.6 \text{ Hours}$$

With the software this dramatically reduced down to

$$50 * 1.5 \text{ (an average time)} = 75 \text{ Minutes} = 1.25 \text{ hours.}$$

With the software you would be able to promote over 5 times the number of sites in the take it would take to promote a single site. Now this is a time saver at its best.

Note that you can carry out the whole sign up / verify emails / create link all within a single window if you wish to do so.

## **Software Stages Summary**

Note that the software has only been verified to work in the following environments:

- Windows XP (sp2 / sp3) with IE7 / IE8
- Vista 32 bit with IE7 / IE7
- Windows 7 – 32 bit / Windows 7 - 64 bit

The software itself is broken down into a number of simple steps and processes to allow the process of creating one way authority links back to you own sites and domains.

The software is broken down into manageable chunks as follow:

### **Stage 1) Import Links directly into the software or create your own links**

This stage allows you to import links direct into the software from adobe PDF files. You can import a single file or a full directory of files.

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### **Stage 2) Create a web site to promote**

This stage allows you to create a 'web site' profile to be promoted. Simply enter all of the details (i.e. you name / URL / signature and emails etc) then save the website profile to use.

If you have multiple sites to promote (for client for example) then create several different profiles with different URL and data.

### **Stage 3) Create all your site accounts**

This stage simply allows you to go through and create all of your authority site accounts. You will use these accounts to place your one way links on the signup sites.

For this stage you simply choose a profile and that data will be used to signup for the chosen sites. There is an auto fill function to make signups super simple and super quick.

So we simply goto the site click the 'register' or 'sign' link and when the page has loaded we simply right click the mouse and 'auto fill' the data (no manual typing here) then click submit then your done.

We then move onto the next site and sign up in exactly the same way.

You can create the signups / verify your email and create the links back to your site are the same time within this window if you prefer and this is covered later in the document.

### **Stage 4) Goto your email and confirm all of your account signups**

This stage is simply the verification that the sites require to ensure that you are not a spam 'bot' signing up to their site.

Simply goto your email and click the verification links to activate your account. AT stage we also change any auto generated password from the sites to our default password that we used within our site profile.

### **Stage 5) Create your one way link backs to your web site.**

This stage allows for the easy creation of one way link backs to our site we want to promote. You can now select all, or a number of sites from the list that you signed up for in stage 3 to create the high PR back links. Personally I choose around 10 links a day to promote back to my site but you can choose as many links as you feel comfortable with; after selection you click the 'Create' button.

A browser will open and navigate to the sites in turn. Simply goto the 'sign in' or 'login' link and right click the mouse and choose 'auto fill' and the login field will be populated. Then click 'submit' and you will be logged in.

Goto 'edit' profile then again right click the mouse and choose 'auto fill' and the fields will be populated from your profile data. Goto your signature field and remove either the BB Code link or the HTML code Link depending on what types the site accepts.

Then we choose the 'navigate to next site' button and were done.

How easy is that? I save huge amount of time creating my signups and links this way.

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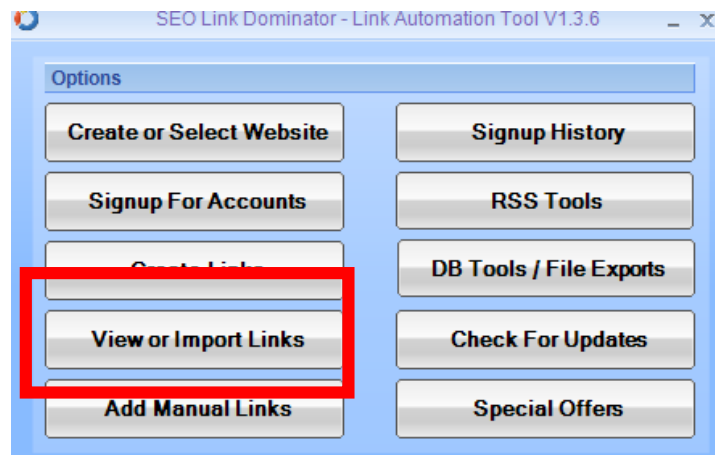
**Stage 6)** Create RSS channels to promote you url's. Now publish the rss channel online then once published, submit to the RSS directories. You can also optionally ping your urls.

**Stage 7)** This is an optional stage but you can display and export your signup history and url link to submit to social bookmarking sites and rss.

This stage allows you to export your signup history to 'csv' file format for a given profile and group of links.

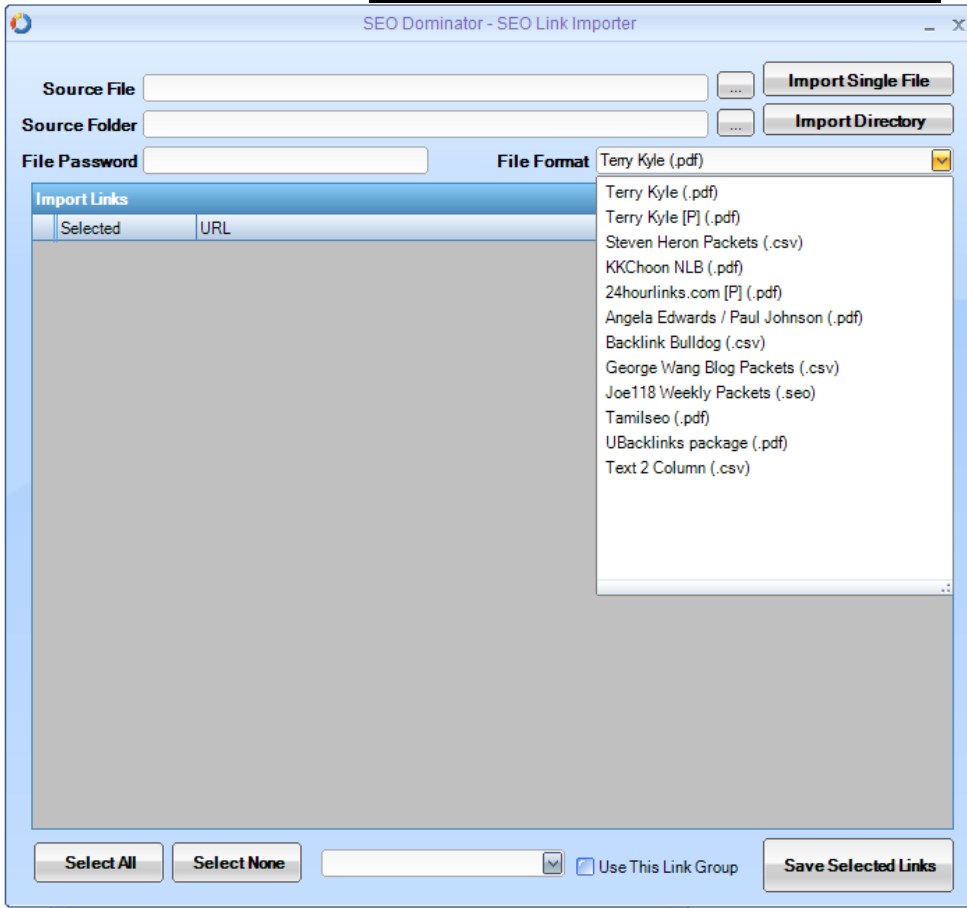
## **Stage 1 – Importing your Links**

Click the 'View or Import Links' Button to start off the import process

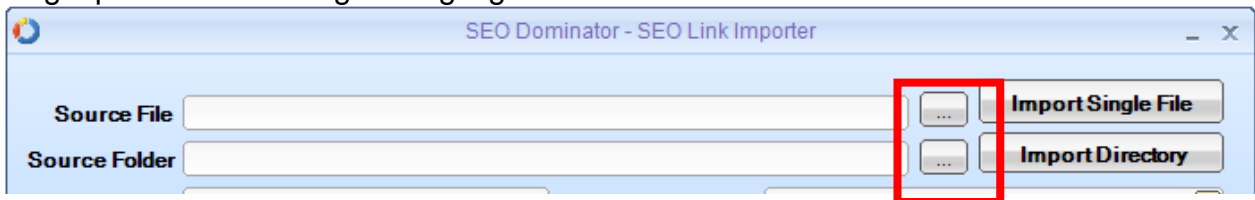


The following screen will be opened

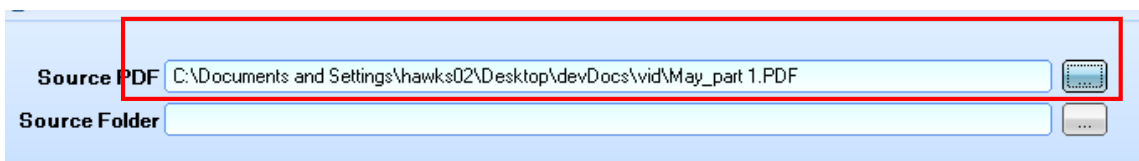
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Choose to either 'import a single pdf' or a 'folder containing several pdfs' of links. Find the single pdf or folder using the highlights button shown

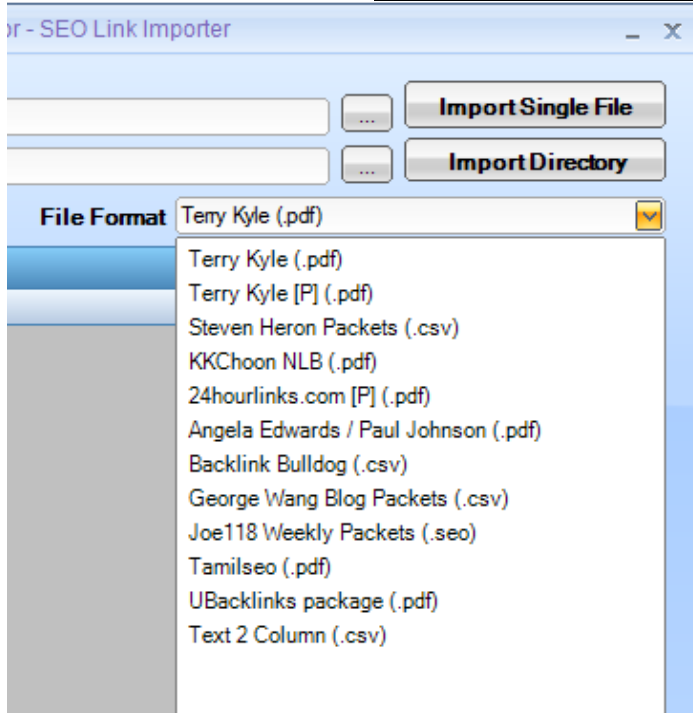


Once you have chosen your links PDF you will see something similar to the following



Now you need to choose the package type you are importing into the software. This can be done via the dropdown list as shown:

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NOTE: if you choose a package with a **[P]** in the name then you **MUST** provide a password to open that package type. If the pdf does not have a password or the password is incorrect then the import will fail. You must also select the correct file type that the package process uses. This is shown at the end of the package name:

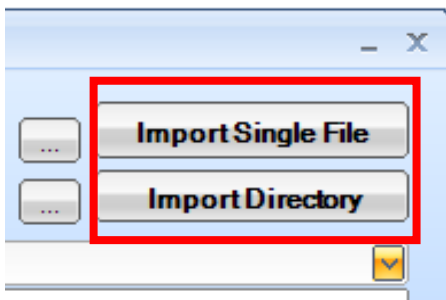



Now we need to import the data and choose the links we want to import. For this we simply use either the 'Import Single File' button if chose a single PDF to import (as above) or 'Import Directory' to import several data files at once.



We click the 'Import Single PDF' button in this example and the following data is retrieved and displayed. By default all the links will be selected automatically.

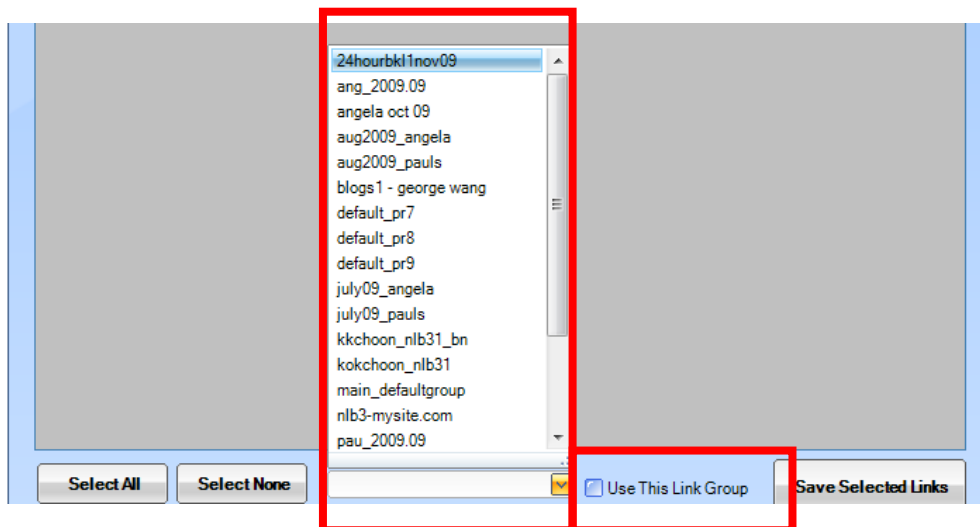
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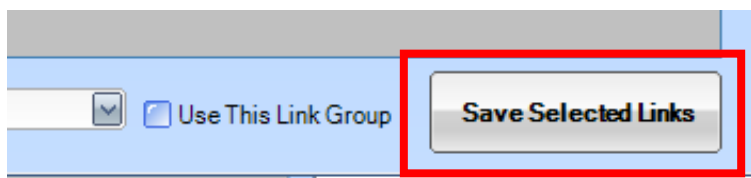

If you wish to unselect any of the links then simply click on the check box to remove the 'tick' against the web site.

Now we need to decide to either save all of the links shown under a new name or to add the links within a previously saved group of links already saved. To add the links to a group already save we simply click the 'Use This Profile' and choose a group from the drop down list as shown



Then click the 'Save Selected Links' button



The links have now been saved.

To save the links to a new group (for example August2009\_PaulsLinks) you uncheck the 'Use this profile' check box and simply click the 'Save Selected Links' button and the following will pop up for you to enter your new name into as shown then click the 'Save' button to save the links.

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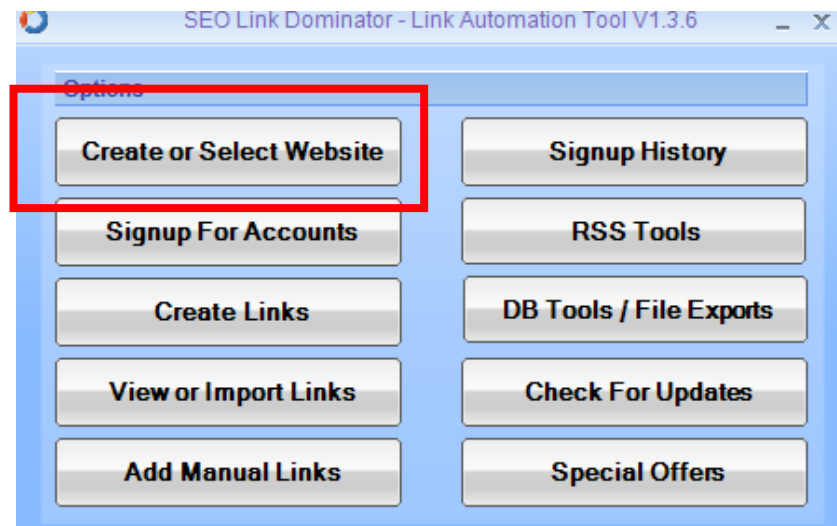


That is all there is to import and save your links.

Note that you cannot save the same link twice and a popup will let you know if the web site already exists within the software.


## Creating your web site profile data

This process allows you to create multiple profiles for your different web sites that you want to promote and create free links back to. Click on the button shown to start off this process:



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The following screen will open. The first profile in the screen will be chosen by default:

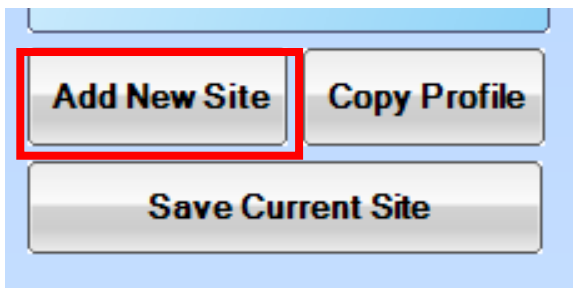



To create a new Profile click the 'Add new Site' button.



Add the profile name and click Save




The 'Create new Profile' dialog box shows the following details:

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Now fill the all of the data items for 'ALL' of the fields. Note that all fields must be filled in for a profile to be choosable within the other screens within 'seo link dominator'. If all fields do not contain data then you will 'NOT' see the profile name in the link creation screens.

Note that if you don't have an email account you can semi-auto create a 'Yahoo or Google email' accounts by clicking the 'Create' button next to the email input box. For this to work you must have entered your 'first name', 'last name', 'username' and 'password' that you want to use for the account. Yahoo is the default email due to the additional verification process Gmail have introduced.

Note after you enter the 'captcha' and signup you 'MUST' login into your yahoo mail account in the browser window before closing the window to allow the software to pickup the new email account details. If you do not then you will have to manually type in your new email account details into the web site 'email' field manually. You may want to take note of your email address during signup.

Note that the email details will be auto filled for you but you must 'Enter the Captcha' then click 'I accept Create My Account'

The **Anchor text AND Description Field** are both spinnable. You set your 'spinnable text and descriptions' for your url matching. You 'MUST' separate any anchor text / description text with a pipe '|' to add alternative phrases. Do not add the pipe at the start or end of the anchor text.

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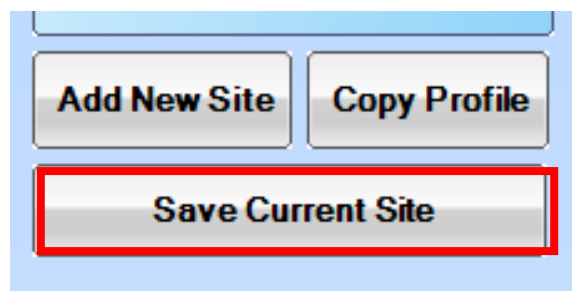
Next add your **description**, this will be used in your BIO / Signature field on within your profiles in which you create your links. Your URL's will be automatically added in one of the following formats (determined by you) on the sign up / create links browser pages:

- HTML links
- BBCode links
- Textule links

Next add all of your URL's you want to put on your links pages. Seo link dominator will spin '2' of the urls and anchor text and place the links at the end of your bio / signature field. If you want particular anchor to appear against the url then match the field position.

Note that any URL's added must have **http://** OR **https://** at the start.

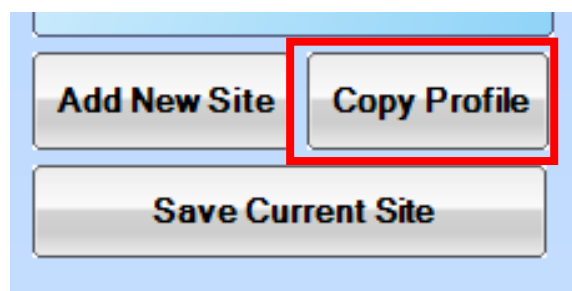
Click on 'save Current Site' to save the profile changes



NOTE THAT YOU **MUST** CLICK ON THE '**SAVE CURRENT SITE**' BUTTON AFTER YOU MAKE ANY CHANGES OR THEY WILL **NOT** BE SAVED.

### **Copying Profiles**

Click the 'Copy profile' button to copy the displayed profile on the screen. The whole profile is copied except for the 'urls' and email. The username is also reset to new the profile name.



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### **Matching spin text and URL's**

You match your spinnable items by pairing them up within the lists as follows:

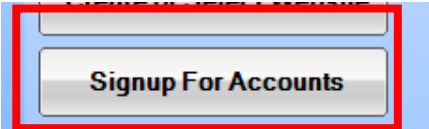

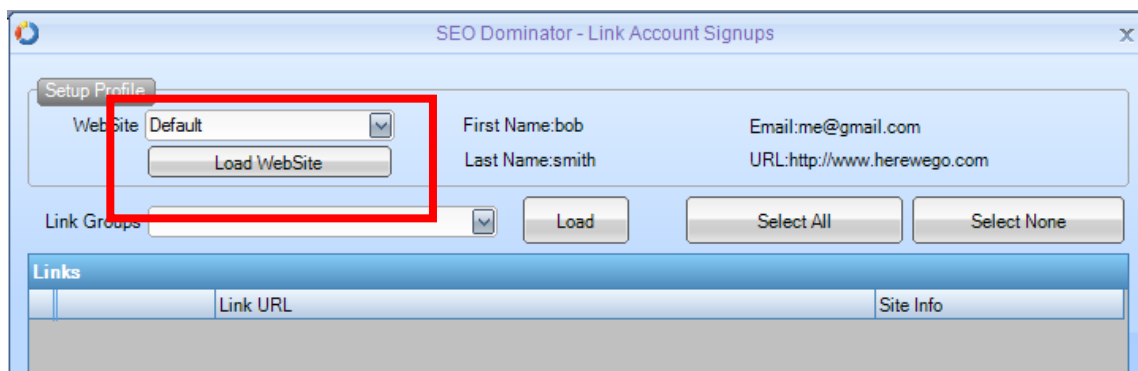
## Creating Your Signups

Within this section I will cover the two ways to use the signups sections.

We start off by clicking the ‘Signup for accounts’ button as shown below



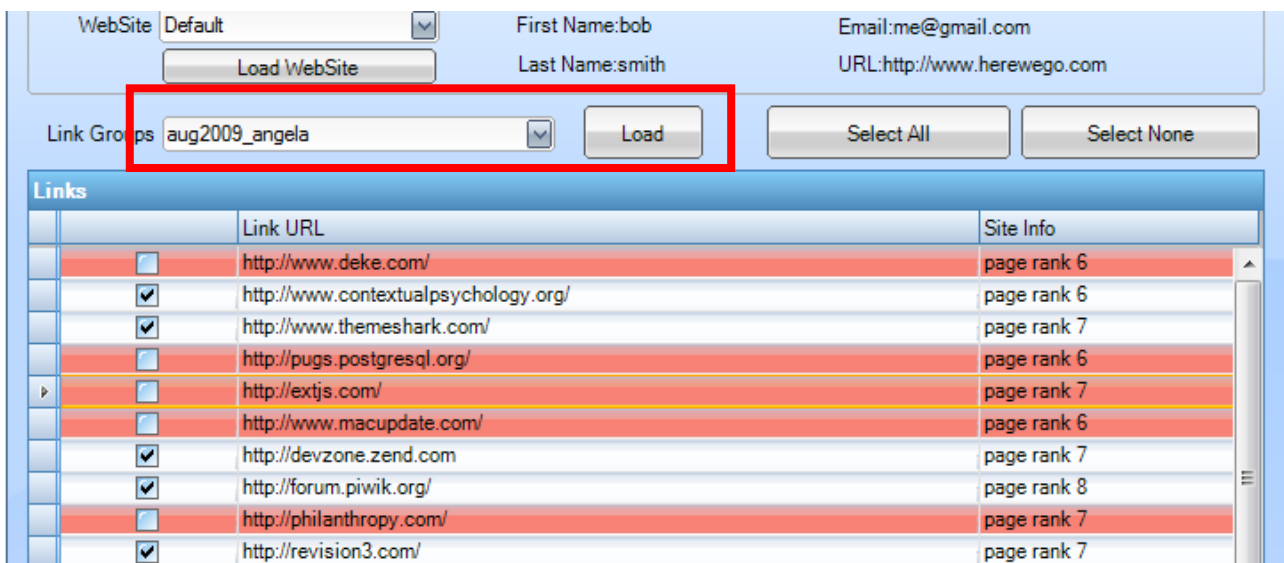
This will open the following screen:



The first thing we do is to choose the website profile that we want to use to create the signup accounts. Now click the ‘Load Web Site’ button. This will load the web site profile that you wish to use.

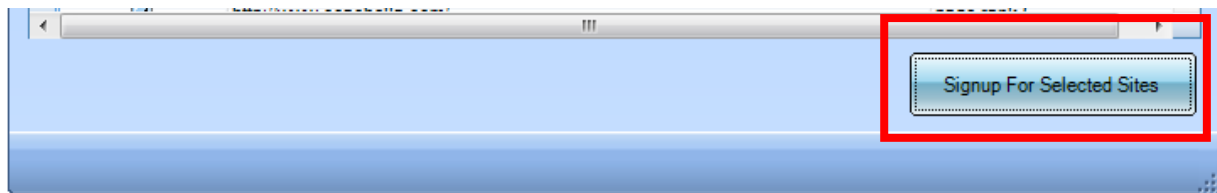
Now choose the group of links that you wish to signup i.e. ‘Aug\_2009\_Angelas’ and click the ‘Load button’. A list of the urls within that group will be displayed. Any web site URL’s shown in red are urls that the profile has already signup against.

The entire web sites shown in red will automatically be deselected as signup sites when the list shown and also after the signups have been completed.

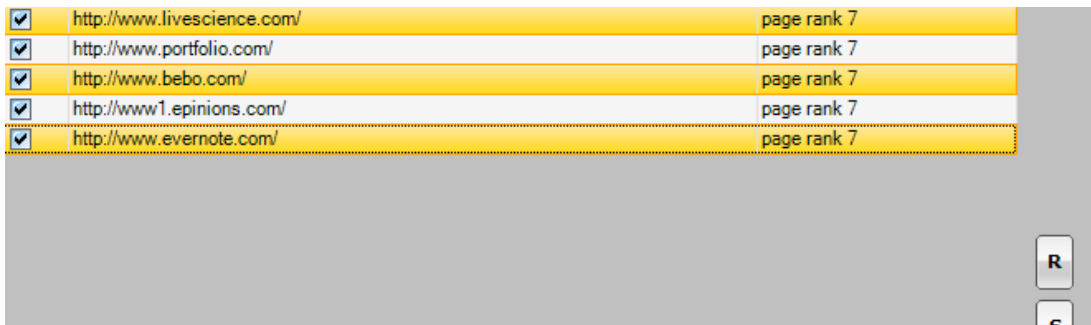


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Now with your selected signups go and click the button 'Signup for Selected Sites' as shown below



Note you can choose selected sites by holding down the 'ctrl' key and clicking those sites in the grid. The 'R' button remove those checked items and the 'S' button selects the chosen items in the list.



The signup browser window will now be displayed.



Note that the signup browser can be used in 2 ways

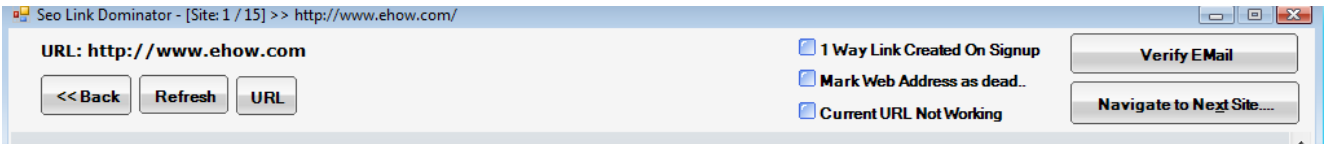

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- 1) Carry out your signups only and complete the link creation at a later stage
- 2) Carry out signups / email verification and link creation all at the same time

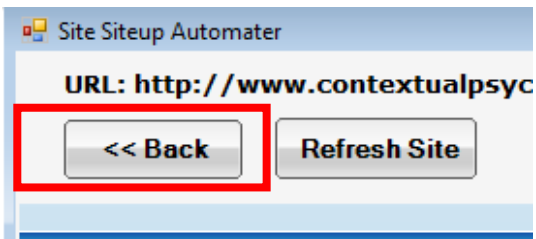
I will go through the process showing both of these options and signify when we finished the signup stage.

The browser window has the following button options:



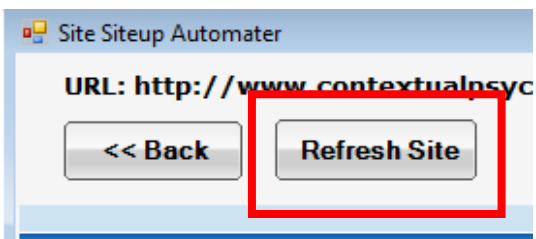
### **Back Button:**

This is used to go back to your previous page on a web site. I.e. You click the wrong link for the above site and need to return back to the last page on the same site.



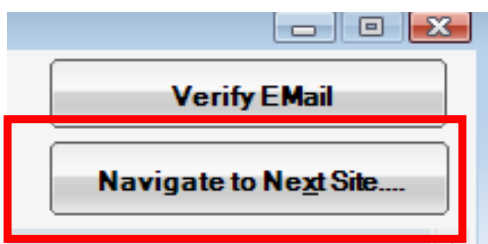
### **Refresh Site Button:**

This is used to refresh the page on the current website. The web site may fail to load if the website itself is slow or it may time out. If this happens then simply press the 'refresh button'



### **Navigate to next Site Button:**

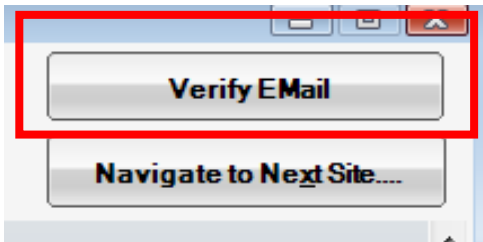
The 'navigate to the next site' button will save the current site history (as a signup – see the additional option available later in this section) and navigate to the next site in your list.



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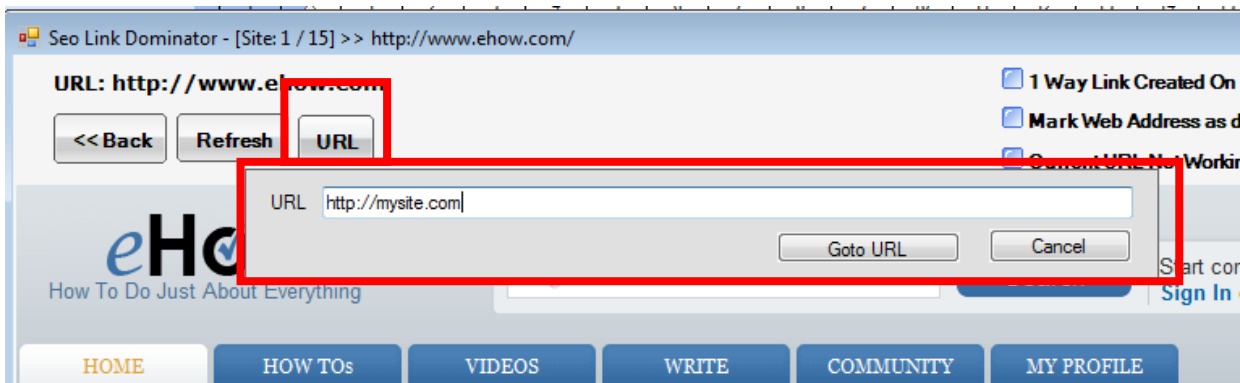
### Verify Email Button:

The 'Verify Email' button will open a new browser window and automatically login to your Email with the account that has been setup within the web site Profile.



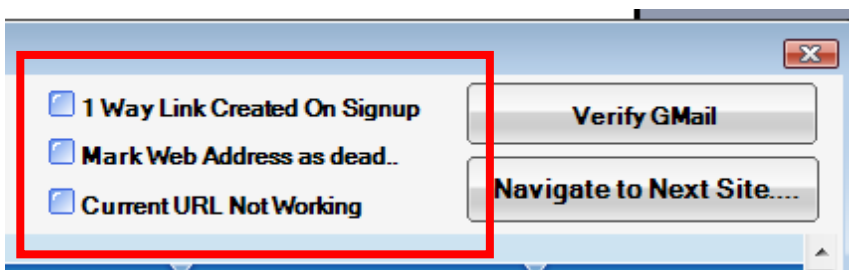
### URL Button:

The 'URL' button allows you to navigate to any external site that you paste into the url popup. This can be used to navigate to sites you do not have imported in 'SEO Link Dominator' or to a custom url.



### Check box options:

The following check box options are available within the 'signup browser' screen. Each of the option will be discussed within this section.




### Mark Web Address as Dead:

This option is only to be check when a URL that has been displayed (or rather not displayed) is a dead URL and is no longer valid. Do not confuse this with a 'url that is not working'.

If a URL is marked as dead then it 'will' be completely removed from our main list of URL's in our lists of URL's.




**Mark Web Address as dead..**

### **Current URL Not Working:**

This option is to be used when a web site is opened within the browser but for some reason cannot be loaded.. This may be due to the site timing out or just NOT working at the time when we try to signup for it.

Also use this option if you try and signup and the signup itself isn't working and move onto the next site in our list of sites that we chose.




**Current URL Not Working**

### **1 Way Link Created On Signup:**

This option is to be used when you both signup for your account on the site and create your link at the same time. This option updates the software to set the website as having created a link back for the profile we are using.


This also removes the website from the 'web link creation' process which lists only the sites that you have signed up for and not created link back on.




**1 Way Link Created On Signup**

### **Site Progress and Current Site:**

The 'Current URL' is shown within the 'title bar' for the current domain.



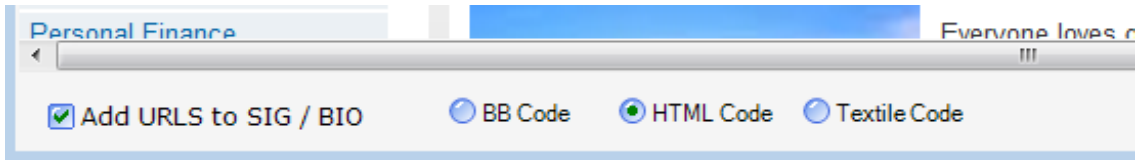

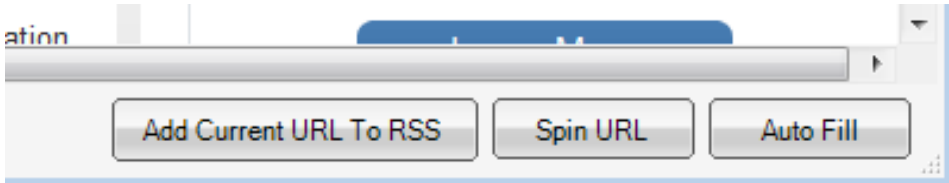

You can track your progress through your chosen site list within the tool bar. The progress shown before the current URL in the title bar as 'Site: N of X'

## **Spinning and URL link Options**



Tick the 'Add urls to sig / bio' to enable the links and anchor text to be automatically added on the auto fill function. Choose the type of code to be added by selecting the 'bbcode', 'html code' or 'textile code' types.



### **Add Current URL to RSS**

When you add a link to the web site you have signed up against To enable quick indexing of the page within google / yahoo and bing; you goto the 'public viewable' page where you can see your link and clicc the 'Add current URL to RSS' and it adds the page url to both the export data and the RSS feeds data.

### **Spin URL**

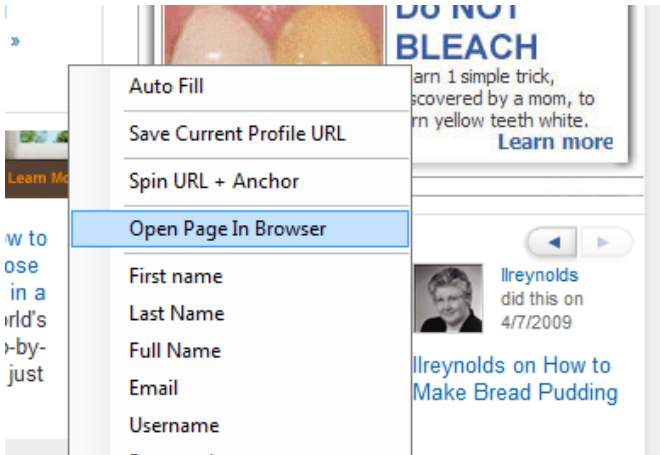
Click the 'Spin URL' to manually spin the URL / anchor text on the page. The automatic spinning is carried out when you click the 'navigate to next site'.

### **Auto Fill**

The auto fill button carries out the same action as the 'right-click → auto fill' function and this is discussed later in this document.

## **Opening the Current Page in an External Browser**

An essential part during your link building process is to verify if your public viewable links show up within an external browser of your choice. The browser is set within the 'setting / tools' menu screen and is defaulted to 'Internet explorer'. You open the current page by right clicking the mouse and selecting the 'Open page In Browser' from the menu list.



## **ShortKeys within the Browser Screens**

Short keys have been introduced to make your link building even faster. The following short cut keys are available within 'Both' browser screens:

Copy Current URL to the Windows ClipBoard → **ALT + C**

Navigate to Next Site → **ALT + X**

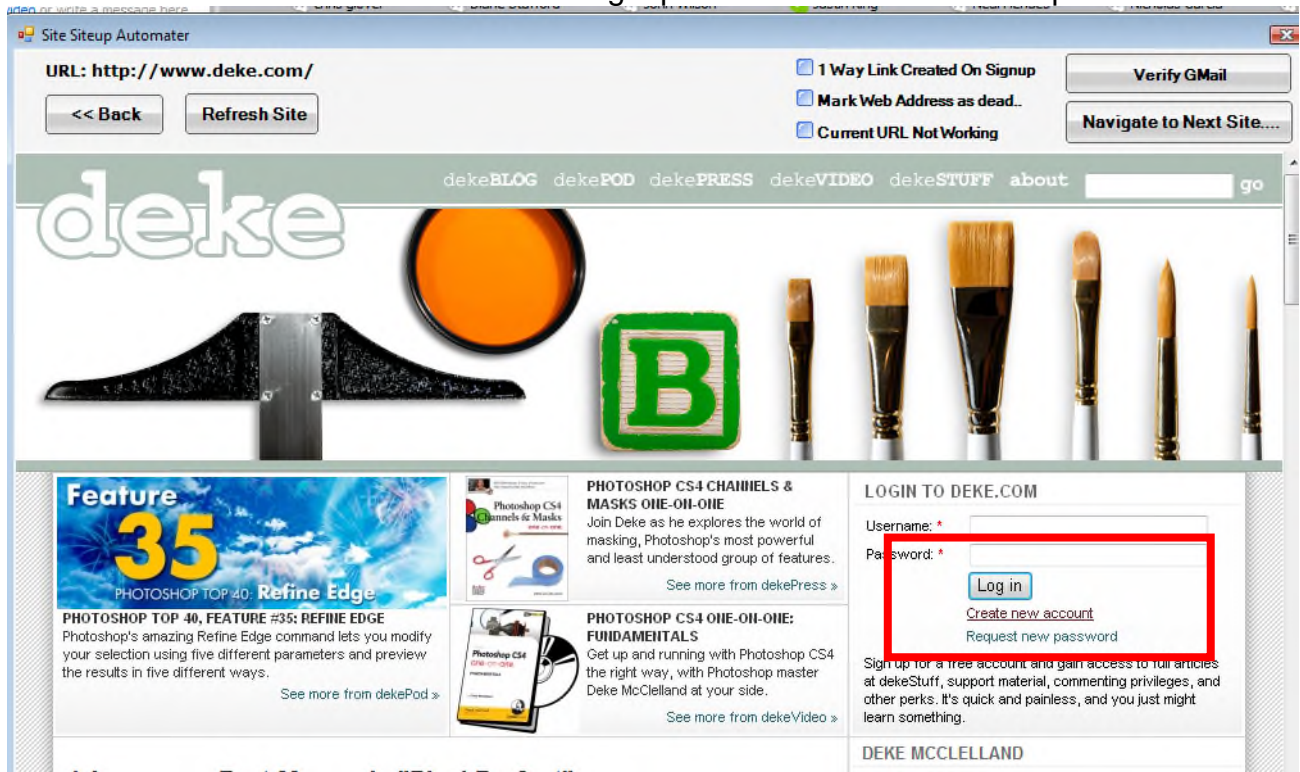
AutoFill the current page → **ALT + A**

Add Current URL to RSS → **ALT + R**

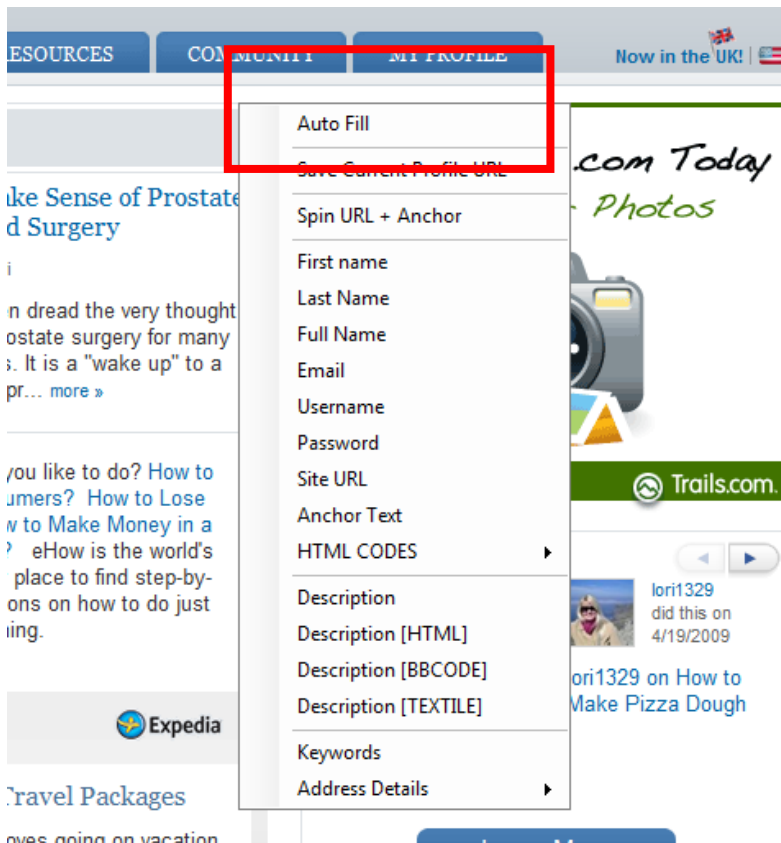

### Signup browser processing:

We are at our first site and now click the signup on the site as in the example below




This takes us to the signup page and this is the cool bit 😊. Whilst on this page we 'right click the mouse' and choose 'Auto Fill'



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And all of the fields get automatically filled with the data that you added to your 'web site profile'. If in the rare instance any of the fields do not then simply click your mouse within the field on the page and select the item from the 'right click' menu.

Note that captcha's will not be automatically filled in as in the above example:







Now click the 'verify Gmail' button to open and auto login to our Gmail account and find the verification email.



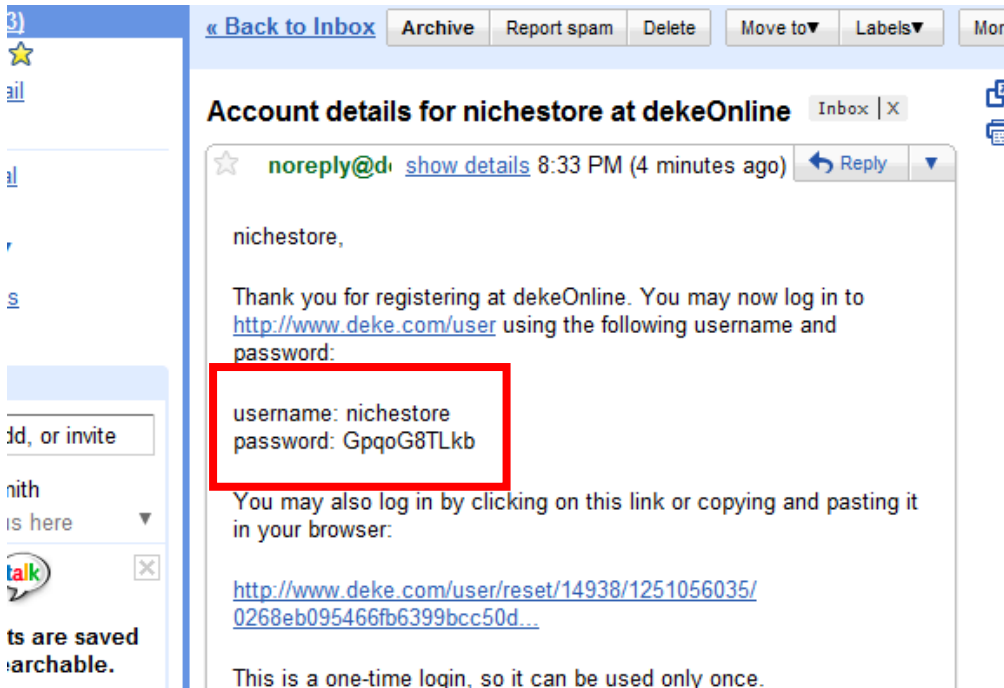

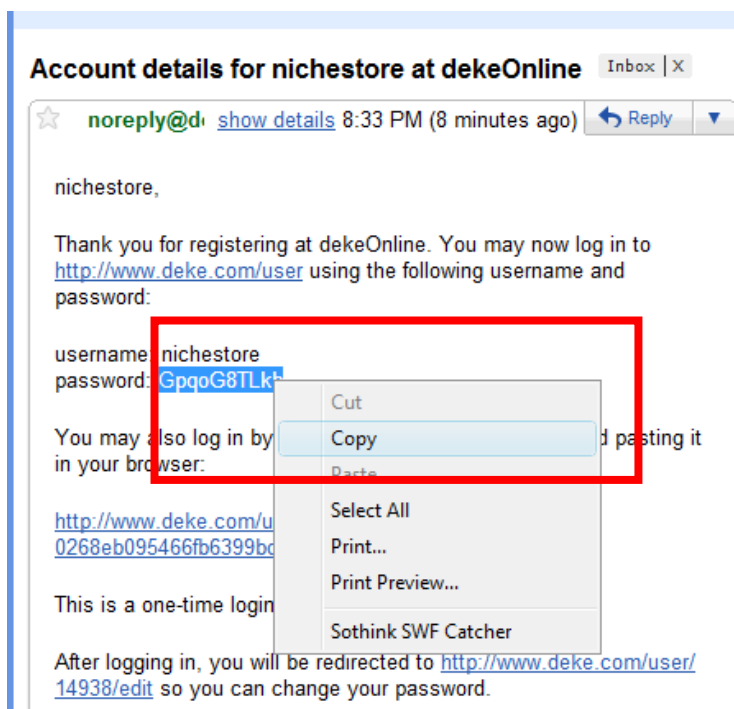

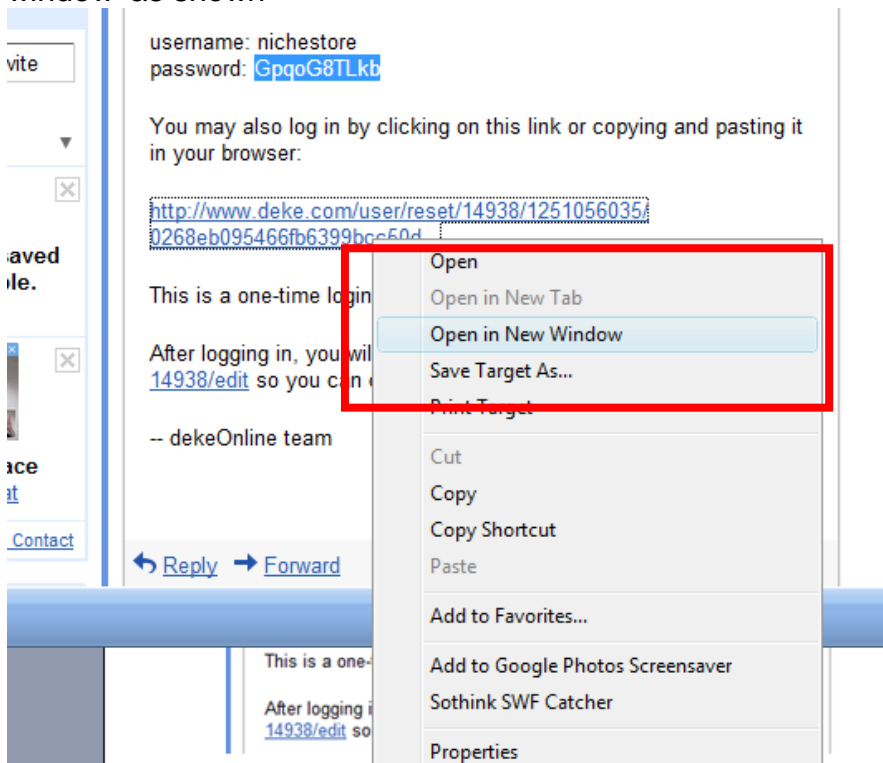
Note here as with a lot of website that the password will be auto generated and we 'MUST' change this to the password that we setup within our website profile.

So in this case we need to change the password from 'GpqoG8TLkb' to 'nichepsz178' so that we can use the auto login features of the software. Let do that now. So copy the password by highlighting it and right click the mouse and copy as shown:



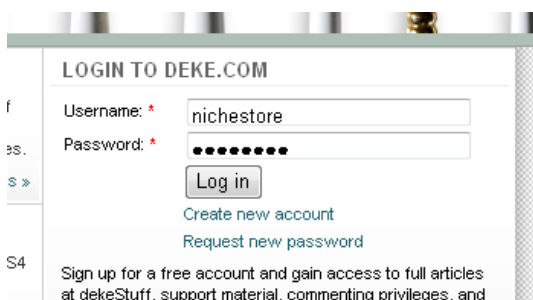
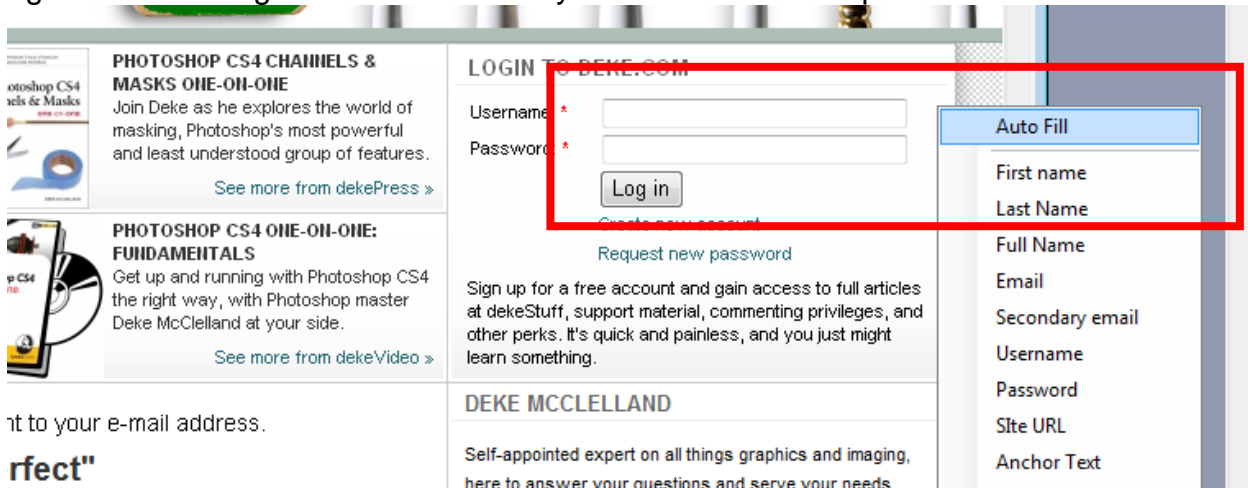

Note that if you use the link direct to login and edit your password to your default on or to click the verify link, the easiest option is to 'right click' the link and choose 'open in a new window' as shown



Whilst you continue to do signup and create links back to your web site you can simply leave the Gmail verifier window open.

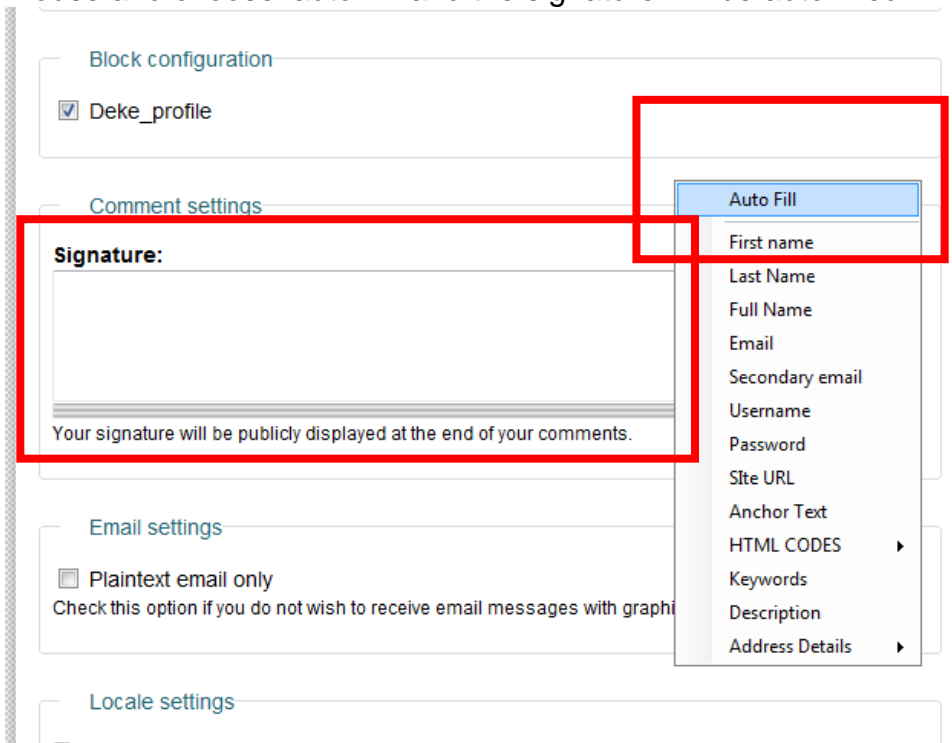
Now go back to the signup screen that we left to verify the email and right click the mouse again and once again 'auto fill' to fill in your 'username' and 'password' as shown



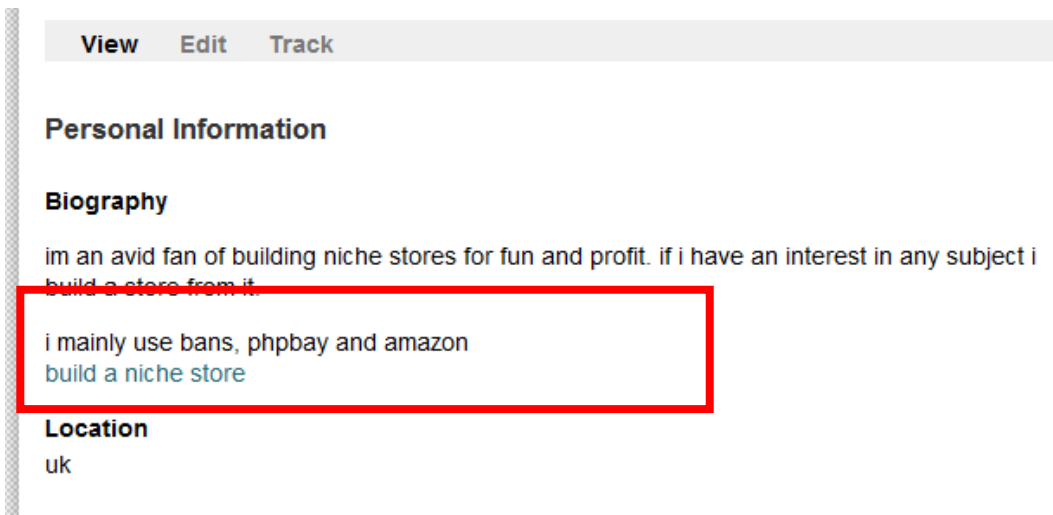
And click 'Log in' to get logged in.

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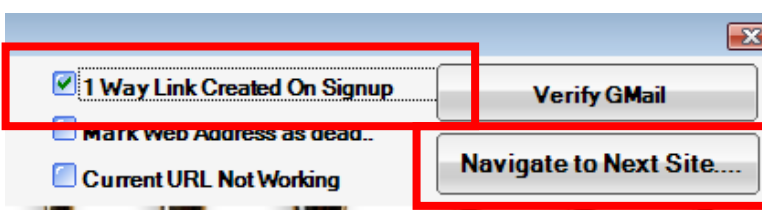
Now goto the profile page for your account (see the pdf included with this course for more details) and we will be presented with the following. We simply once again 'right click' the mouse and choose 'auto fill' and the signature will be auto filled in.



Note that the signature will contain ONLY BB Code / HTML code or textile code BASED on your selection within the browser window itself.



The next step is to set the link as fully completed. To do this we need to set the '**1 way link created on signup**'. THIS MUST BE SET TO SET THE COMPLETED HISTORY ON THE LINK FOR THE WEBSITE PROFILE.



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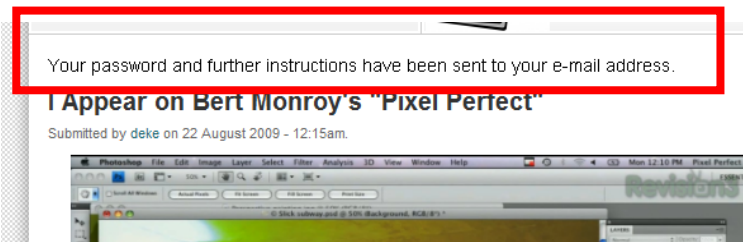
Now simply click on the 'Navigate to next Site' to move onto the next site in our list.

Our signups are that simply.

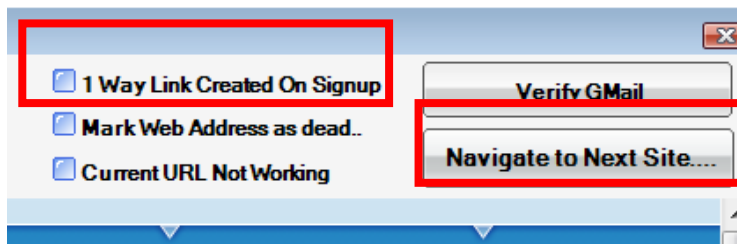
### **Separate sign up and link creation**

This is the second type of signup that can be done. We simply signup to the site and once we see the 'email has been sent' or 'verification email has been sent to your mail address' or something similar then we simply click on the 'navigate to next Site' button and just signup for our accounts.

An example of this message from the last section would have been as follows

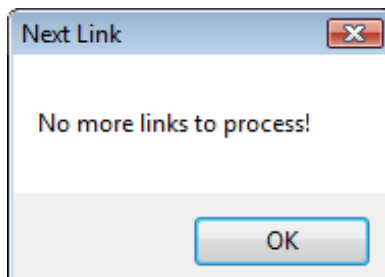


After receiving this message you would simply click the 'navigate to next Site' button



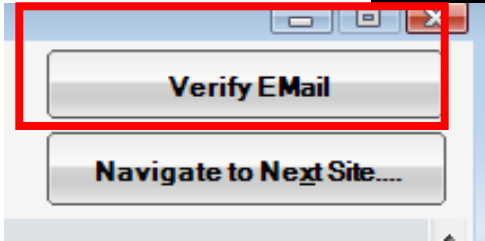
Note that the '1 way link created on signup' is not 'ticked'

When we create our signup accounts this way, when we reach the end of our list of signups we will receive the following message displayed.



We can then verify the emails by clicking on the 'verify Email' button in the browser window then close the Email window and signup browser window when finished.

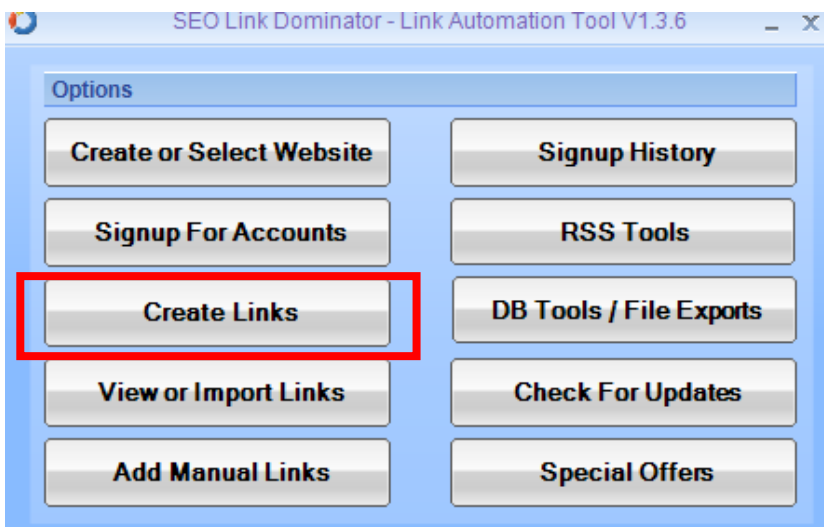

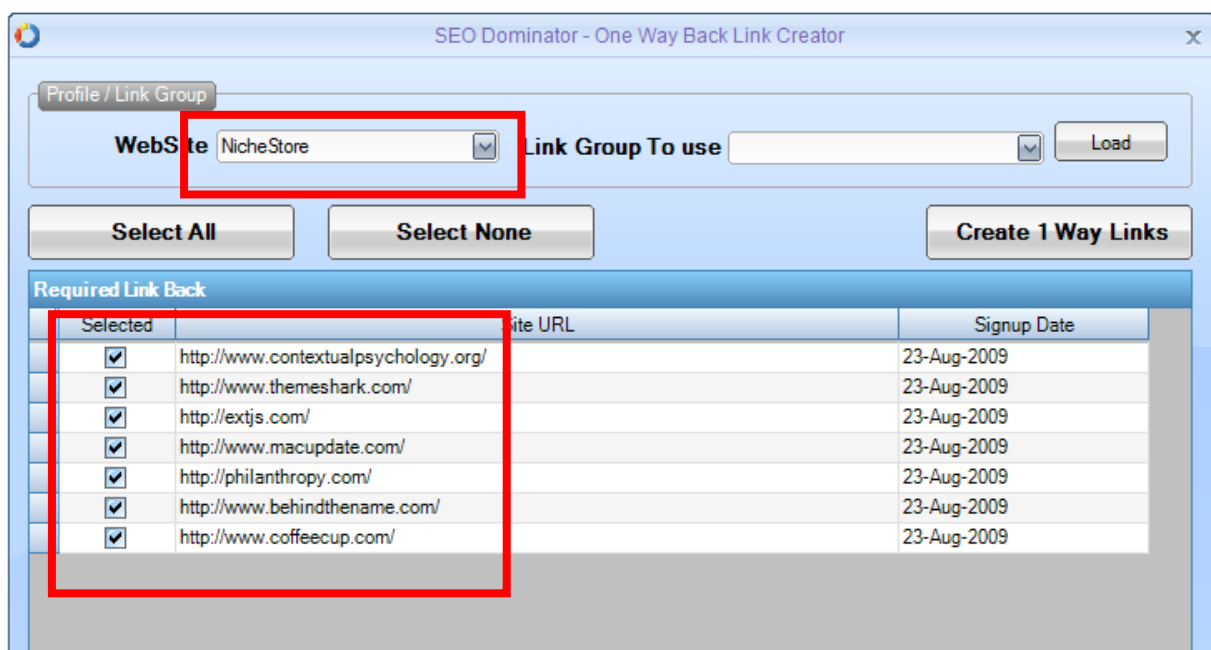
### Create separate links for Signups

This section of the guide is ONLY if you have only create the signup accounts and not created your 1 way link backs within the same step (as described previously).

For this step we select the 'Create Links' Button from the main menu as shown

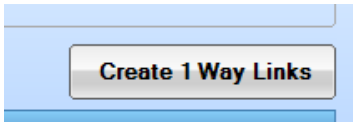


This will open the following screen. Note that if you have loaded a web site profile in the software it will use that profile whilst the software is open and select all of the signup sites that you have not created a link on by default.

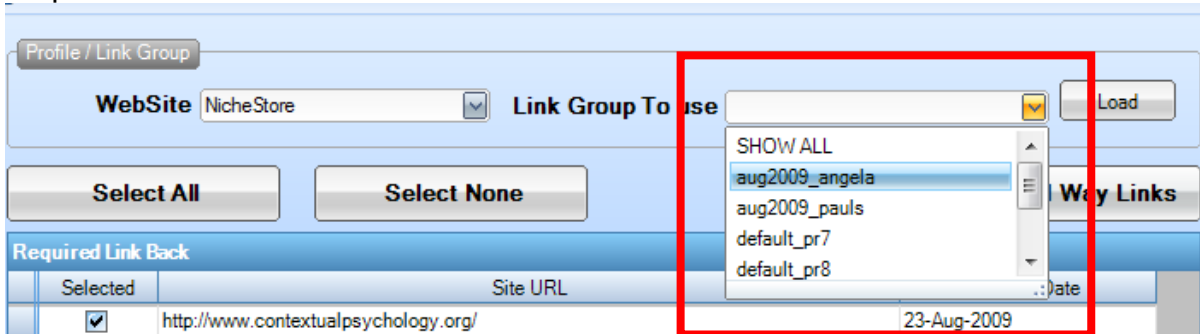


Now select the 'Create 1 Way Links' button to open the link browser.

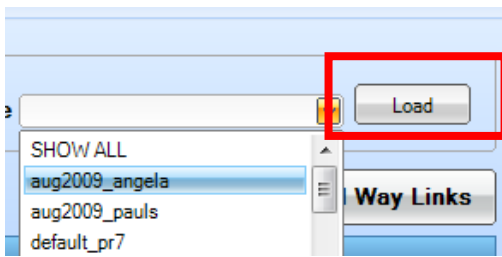

As before to populate the login we 'right click' the mouse and select 'auto fill' to fill in the fields then click login.

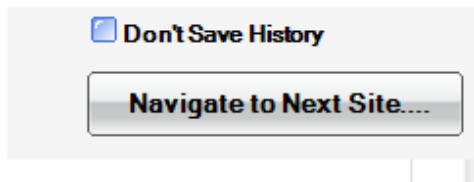
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As earlier we navigate through the site to the profile and right click and 'auto fill' to add in the details.

As earlier once the account or profile has been saved simply click the 'navigate to next site' button.



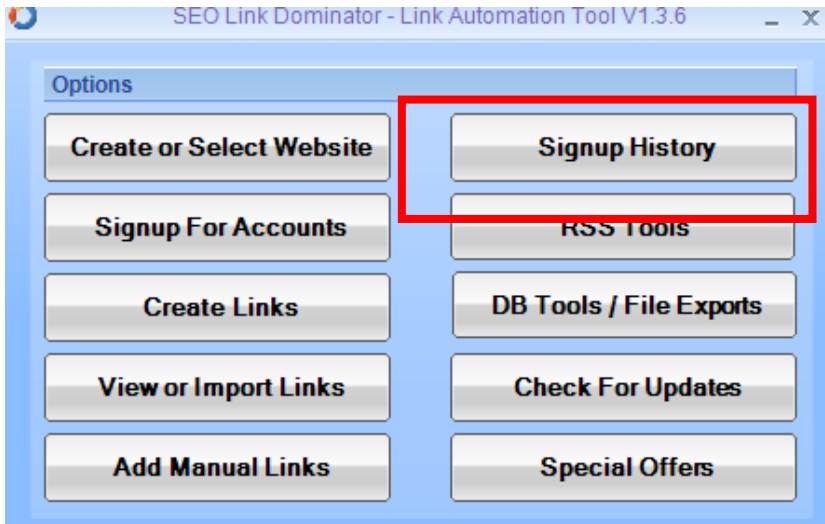
If the site fails at any point or is not responding due to a fault on the site itself then simply tick the 'Don't Save History' button then 'navigate to the next site' button after wards. This will enable you to come back to the site and finish off your link back process.

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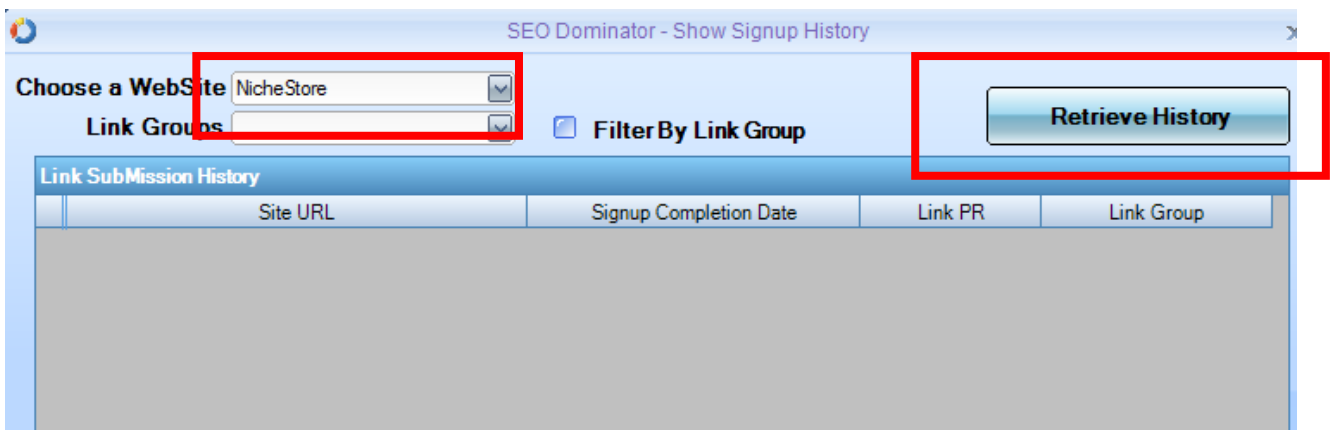
### Signup History export

The signup history screen can be used to display or export the signups that you have 'completed' for a 'web site' profile.

Select the 'Signup History' from the main menu.

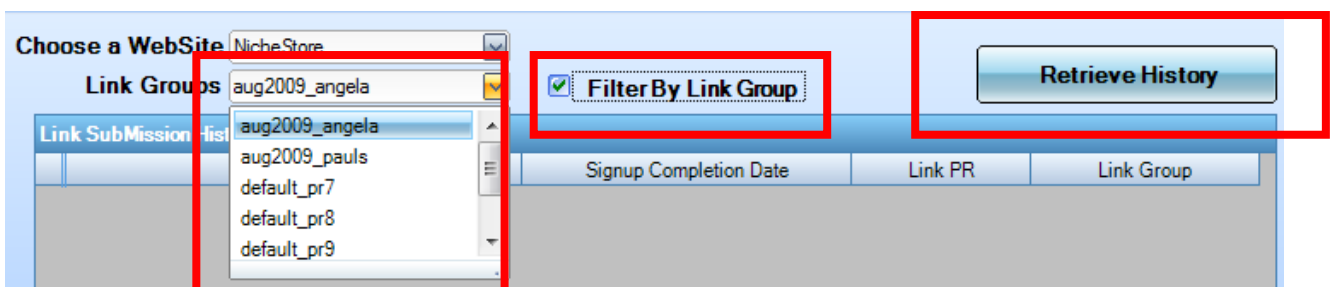

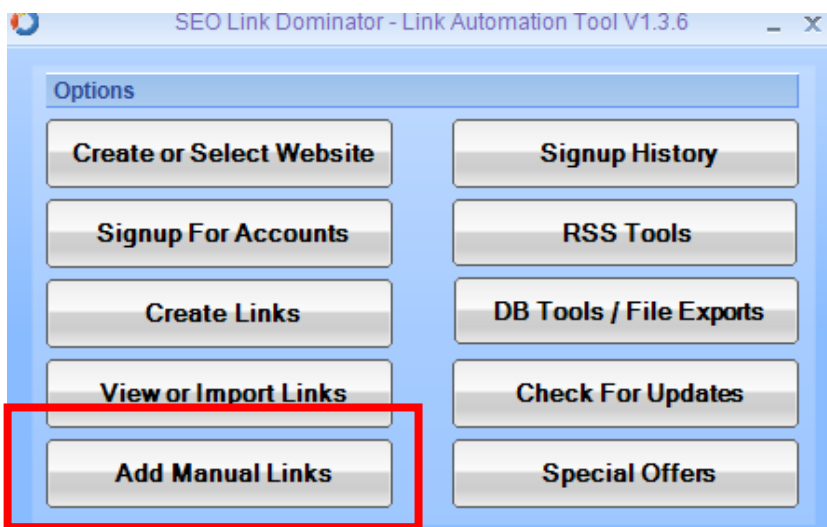

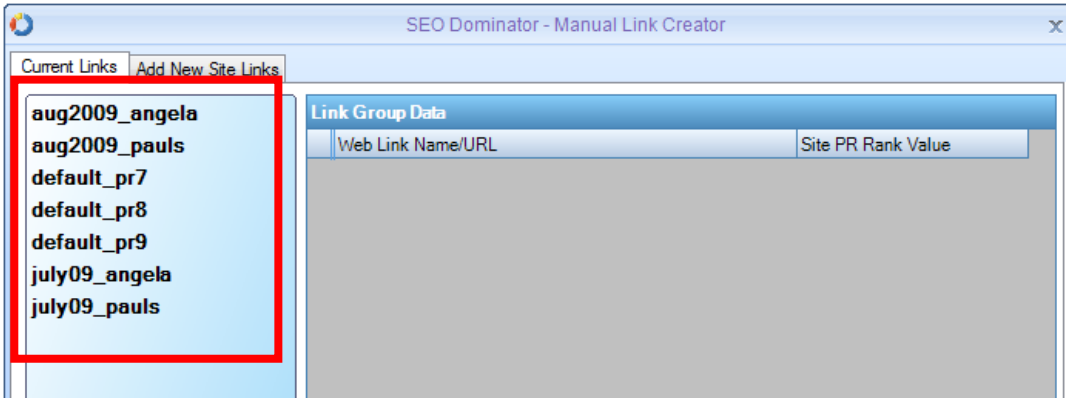

The SEO Dominator software has the ability that allows you to add your own favourite links to the software using the following option



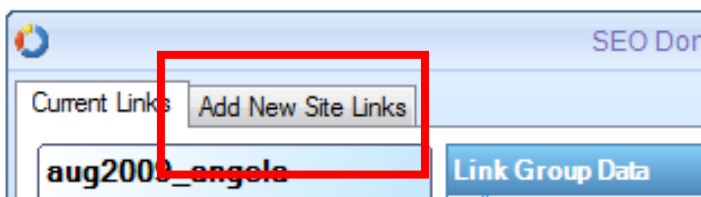
The following screen is displayed and you can view all of the links that you have added or imported into link groups.

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Simply click on the link group name to display all of the links contained within that group.

To add a new web site link click on the 'Add a new site links' tab

What is RSS?

RSS is an abbreviation of either Really Simple Syndication or Rich Site Summary; it depends who you talk to. RSS is the new standard for distributing news and information via the Internet. The information is published via RSS News Feeds.

What is an RSS News Feed?

An RSS news feed is a list of topics which is made available from a web site, using RSS. To read the feed, the user installs a newsreader and enters the URL for the news feed. RSS news feeds are a replacement for email newsletters. Eventually, everyone will be reading their news via an RSS news aggregator.

This way you have full control on what you will receive, without the need for visiting web-sites. The RSS way of reading news also helps to protect you from spam, because you can keep your email address private.

Click the '**Create Ice Rocket Channel**' button to auto create your channel. Note that this will only fail if you did not add all the data in the rss channel section earlier.

Once the RSS Channel opens you then click the 'Create Channel Items' button and the software will go through and auto create each profile link that you assigned within that channel.

NOTE: Do not close the page till the popup box is displayed to say the process is complete. There is also a 10-15 second pause between the items being created to make the process look more natural to ice rocket.





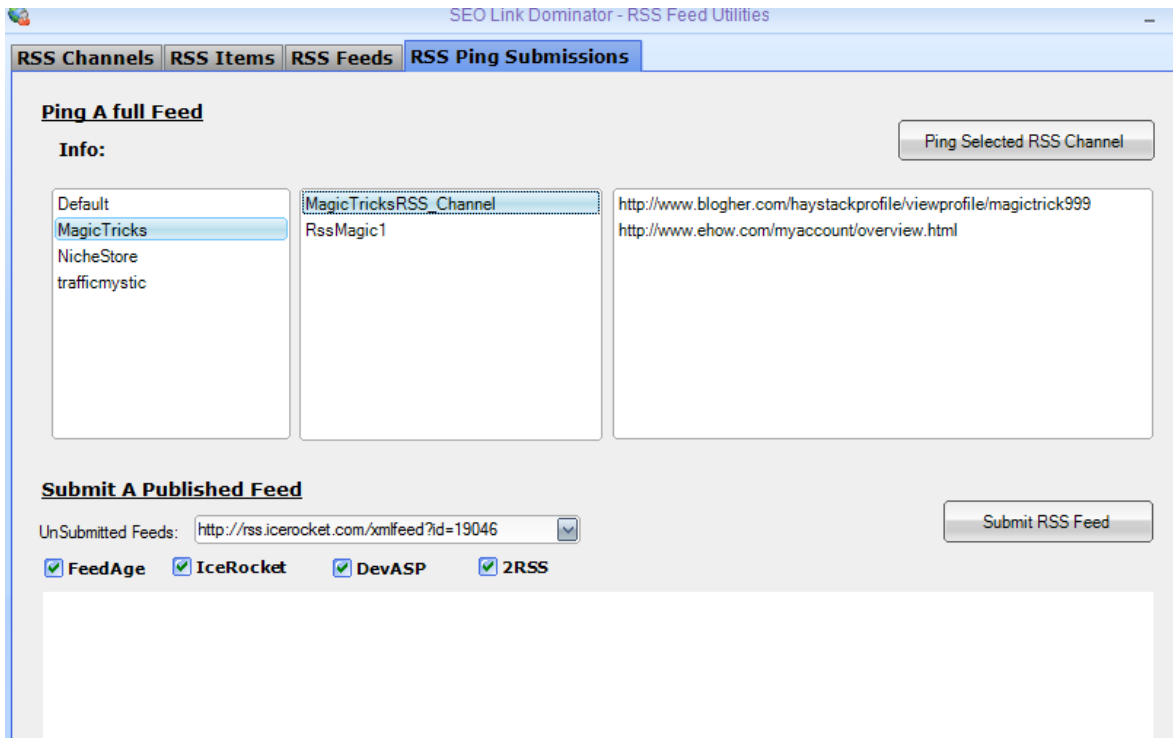

## **Submitting and pinging your URL your feeds**

The ability to recursively ping a rss channel and submit a published feed are available within the RSS feeds screen shown below:



## **Pinging**

To ping a full channel you choose the profile → then choose the channel and all of the urls added to that channel are shown in the right hand site list. Simply click the 'Ping selected RSS Channel' and all urls will be pinged (using anchor and description) to 14 RPC ping sites.

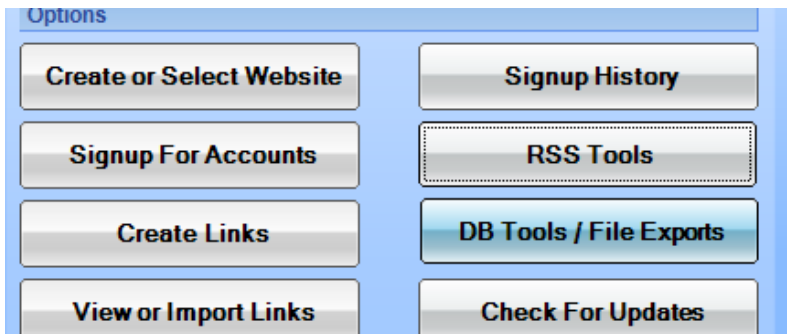
## **Submit RSS feed**

After you have published your RSS feed you can submit that feed to 4 RSS directories. Note that you must signup to 'feedage' and add your login info to the 'setting / tool' screen and save it for it to be used.

Once a RSS feed has been submitted it will be removed from the available list.

**Exporting links to File:**

Click the 'db tools / file exports' option

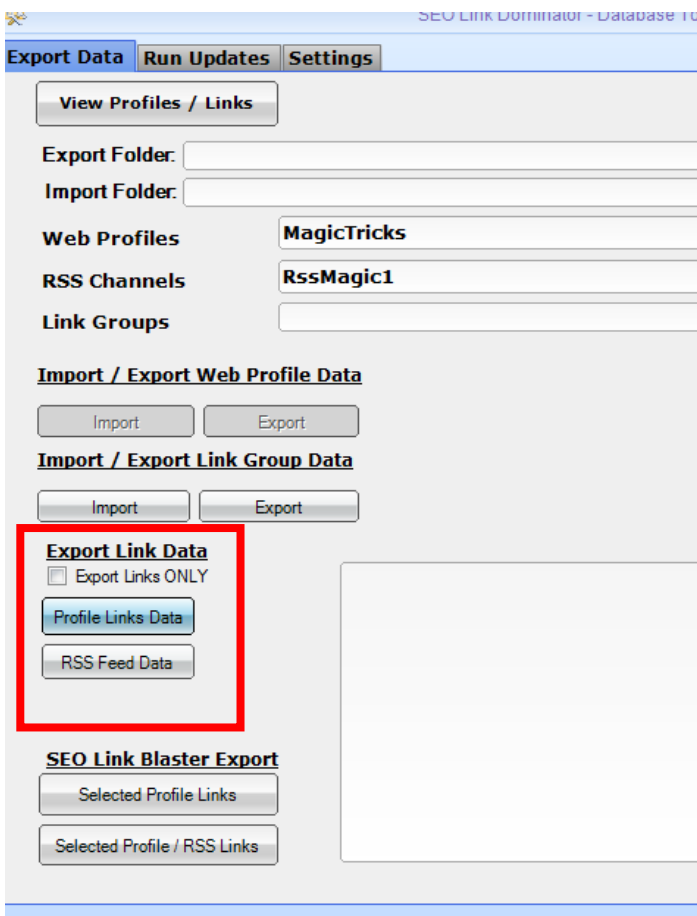


We have 2 options here.

Note: You must choose an export location and a web profile.

Option 1: export your saved profile links (as shown earlier) as a list of url's that you can use for bookmarking etc.

Simply click the 'Export profile Links data' to export to file. The filename is shown in the information area.




Select the 'export Links Only' to export only links and no pr or profile information.

## **Importing / Exporting Link Groups**

You can export any link group that you have imported via the 'import screens'. You can also import any link group you have 'Exported' via the 'tools / setting' screen.

This is valuable if you are outsourcing your links or need to back up your link groups or modify them. Maybe you register urls have changed for example.
